# Challenges and Solutions

- Suffering from malnutrition and lacking adequate healthcare
- They can be physically and psychologically injured
- Teachers themselves similarly affected, do not know how to manage or have the tools to do so.



# Challenges and Solutions

- Teachers poorly paid and lack adequate teaching materials
- Children, suffering from hunger
- Some may have to work after their lessons or quit school altogether to contribute to the family
- Educational materials are often in scarce supply



# Challenges and Solutions

- Psychological trauma in children, specifically victims of displacement, bereavement and abandonment
- School premises might be damaged or destroyed outright



# Challenges and Solutions

- Children in refugee camps should be grouped together
- Activities to teach them the principles of equality, of non-discrimination and of respect for the rights of others
- Special training should be given to teachers
